- 1. Goal. A friendly and fun competition between two of the country's premier Tarpon Fishing Clubs leading to comradery between the clubs and
- honor for the world's greatest game fish.
- 2. Who Each team provides 10 anglers in 5 boats (i.e., 2 anglers per boat)
- 3. When Annually on the Saturday of the second full week of May unless otherwise agreed to by both clubs.
- 4. Where Within published boundaries of the host club.
- 5. Host Clubs alternate hosting annually
- Dinner Host club organizes dinner. Guest club provides number of dinner attendees 2 weeks prior to shootout. Attendees may include Anglers, Club Officers, Board Members and their companions.
- 7. Communication Teams designate captains who establish communication at least 2 weeks prior to shootout.
- 8. Shootout Details
  - a. Fish Tarpon in excess of 50 lb
  - b. Qualified Catch - Either team member touches the leader of a
- hooked fish
  - c. Times No lines in water prior to 7:00 am, all lines out of water by 2:00 pm. Leader touches after 2:00 pm do not count.
  - d. Catch Notification. After catching a fish the Captain of the team catching the fish immediately notifies opponent's Captain of catch.
